

Versteigerungsbedingungen

Mit der Teilnahme an der Versteigerung werden folgende Bestimmungen anerkannt: Die angegebenen Preise sind Schätzpreise in Schweizer Franken. Der Ausruf erfolgt in der Regel bei 60%, sofern nicht höhere Angebote vorliegen. Zum Erstpreis wird ein Aufgeld von 15% sowie zusätzlich die Warenumsatzsteuer von 6,2% auf Silbermedaillen und -münzen und auf Goldmedaillen hinzugerechnet, sofern die Auslieferung in der Schweiz stattfindet. Der Gesamtpreis ist nach erfolgtem Zuschlag fällig und bei der Aushändigung in Schweizer Franken zu bezahlen. Für verspätete Zahlungen berechnen wir die banküblichen Verzugszinsen.
