

The buyer cannot claim to act on behalf of a third person.

**The authenticity of the coins is unconditionally guaranteed, without time limit.** All identifications of the items sold in this catalogue are statements of opinion and made in good faith.

The coins will be dispatched by registered and insured mail for the account and the risk of the purchaser. The purchaser is responsible for any dues or taxes outside of Switzerland and is advised to acquaint himself with the formalities. The auctioneer cannot be responsible for contraventions.

The auction is held in Zurich and any legal questions arising shall be determined in Zurich. A buyer consigning commissions or executing room bids acknowledges the acceptance of the above conditions.





### INTRODUCTION

This present text is intended more modestly as a handbook which will give to collectors and students of Venetian coins as complete a picture as research to date will allow of the money issued in an uninterrupted series by the 83 doges of the Venetian Republic. Short essays illustrating the history of the period in so far as it effects the constitutional or practical position of the coinage accompany the description and illustration of each new type and denomination as they appear, in such a way as to show clearly their origin and development. We are tried to give our pages a practical layout so as to enable the reader to see instantly the issues of each doge with related text and illustrations of the coins. We are noted for every coin catalogued metal, theoretical average weight and rarity. We have added to the catalogue of coins of the doges an appendix listing the coins struck by Carolingian and later emperors in the name of the city and autonomous issues which, even if were not all struck by the mint of the Serenissima, nevertheless have on them the name of Venice. To enable a speedier consultation of the main catalogue, we have grouped at the end of the text, with weights and metal, all the exceptional issues from the Venice mint, in billon, silver and gold, which differ in weight from the norm, and the gold pieces struck with over than zecchino dies. Gold coins of this last type, such as the scudo della croce, the ducatello, the ducatone with Saint Justina and their related fractions used be thought of fantasy pieces, albeit authentic products of the mint, but their weights, full multiple or divisions of the zecchino, lead us to catalogue them as true and proper coins.


## THE MINT OF VENICE

### INTRODUCTION

The present volume, a companion work to my publication of a year ago, "The Coinage of the Doges of Venice", is intended to give to collectors and students of the Venetian series as comprehensive as possible a catalogue of all the other issues produced by the city from the end of the XVth century until 1866. The known material has been set out in four principal groups, one and two dealing with the osell of, respectively, Venice herself and the island of Murano. Group three considers the difficult and complex "anomalous coinage", all those series of coins without Doge's names issued by Venice from the early 1400's until 1797. These matters I shall discuss in greater detail when I come to the catalogue of the third group, to which I have appended the coinages of Catherine Corner in Cyprus and the Sanudo family in the Dodecanese on account of their close political and historical ties with contemporary Venetian issues. The fourth and last group consist of the coinage of the Venice mint from the fall of the Republic in 1797 until the ultimate closing-down of the mint itself in 1866. Each coin type illustrated is accompanied by the description of obverse and reverse, together with metal, actual weight of the coin photographed and rarity. Provenances are given at the conclusion of each section and current valuations are at the end of the catalogue.

### FOREWORD

The purpose of this work is to provide a phographically illustrated catalogue of all the types and varieties known at the present day of the coinage struck at the imperial mint, Sacra Moneta, of Aquileia, established at the time of Diocletian's reform of the monetary system, presumably in order to supply currency to the north-western regions of the Roman Empire. The Aquileia mint was opened, therefore, in 294 and closed at some time before 455, during the reign of Valentinian III. The catalogue proper has been augmented by a historical and numismatic commentary which, however, to avoid the twin danger of incompleteness and error, is merely basic. For fuller information on imperial biographies, the city of Aquileia and numismatics in general, the reader is referred to specialized academic works. Translations from Latin of all obverse and reverse legends are to be found in an appendix at the end of this book. In order to offer a complete but accessible classification of the typology of the surviving production of the Aquileia mint over about a century and half, we have adhered to the following, simple though not strictly scientific, arrangement of the text: 1<sup>o</sup>) Titulature. 2<sup>o</sup>) Dating. 3<sup>o</sup>) Metal. 4<sup>o</sup>) Denomination. 5<sup>o</sup>) Mintmark. 6<sup>o</sup>) Photograph and weight. 7<sup>o</sup>) Rarity. 8<sup>o</sup>) Classification.
